## Community Board requests:

---

I contacted Winslow and Villages Community Board to see if they could support the Community Orchard with some equipment. A strimmer is needed to help clear weeds between trees in the summer. The Board has accepted an application.

I asked if Winslow and Villages Community Board would help the Community Allotment. They've accepted an application for a greenhouse which would enable plants to be planted earlier, extend the growing season and grow different species such as peppers, aubergines or chillies. Food from the Community Allotment goes to St Laurence Food Cupboard.

## Wood update

---

The new Winslow and Great Horwood wood - 4 600 trees - is now being planted in February off Great Horwood Road, near Roddimore Farm. Buckinghamshire Council has agreed to my request to set up a Stakeholder Group so local knowledge can help inform the project.

## Winslow Wednesday Market

---

I've made some suggestions to grow the Winslow Wednesday Market, including marketing ideas, which Winslow ABC Traders Association and Winslow and Villages Community Board are taking forward. There's a meeting with Buckinghamshire Council to look at ways of boosting the market.
