There will be a new wood for Winslow and Great Horwood. Buckinghamshire Council is planting over 4,000 trees near Roddimore Farm, off Great Horwood Road. The aim is to plant 4,625 new trees before Christmas. Species include native Black Poplar, Oak, Eared Willow and Blackthorn, which is particularly beneficial to brown hairstreak butterfly larvae.

At a Full Council meeting I asked if Buckinghamshire Council would set up a stakeholder group so the community can be involved with issues such as access to the new wood.
